

VISITOR POLICY

Eagle Lake Camp and Retreat Center

All visitors, including church members, family members of those in a camp activity, or those wishing to sign up for an activity or to perform maintenance on the camp should be directed to the Activity Director or the Resident Manager. Permission to visit specific areas or people, to tour the facility, or even to remain on the grounds will be given only by these managers or directors. Failure of the visitor to comply shall be reported to the Activity Director or the Resident Manager as soon as possible. Organized activity must not be disturbed. It is up to the Activity Director or Resident Manager to maintain good order and discipline.

All staff should greet visitors in a friendly manner. Suspicious vehicles or people must be reported and asked for their purpose in being on the grounds. Ask for identification nicely. Even simple use of lake access or camp space must have the Resident Manager's permission.

If improper conduct of any type is visible the visitor(s) should be asked to correct the problem or to leave immediately.

At the managers discretion if the visitor does not comply with requests, or a camp member or activity may be in danger, or the visitor appears to be an intruder, the director of the activity or the Resident Manager should notify the local legal authorities for assistance.
